



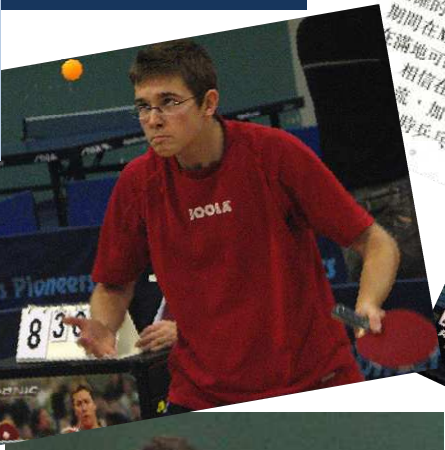

Simon Wei and Giancarlo Cerna are capable of beating any player below 3000 rating and even the ones above the magic number should really beware of them.

Juniors Ling Kun, Young, Arnaud led their team to the second place. However, Montreal 1 will emerge in 2009 much stronger. Young and

We also expect to see Maxime Surpenant or one of younger Quebecers to fight for position in first team.

After the first weekend when the team representing national capitol failed to reveal its true colors, Derek Wong team got stronger by adding Bryan Michaud and the ever improving Bryant Won. Recently he bettered his ratings by a couple of hundreds points. If the next year, the 16 year old Ben Bispham manages to follow his friend, this team will be much tougher to beat.

Montreal and Toronto second team will always be a mix of experience and youth. It is a perfect combination for young and ambitious players that are using the league to sharpen their skills and gain experience.

首屆的乒乓球三市聯賽(滿地可、渥太華和多倫多)經過四輪激戰後,加東盟主終於本月二十三日順利誕生。男子公開組和男子壯年組,均由代表多倫多的My Table Tennis Club (MyTTC) 派出的兩支

勁旅勇奪冠軍。

Comments November 24

Toronto 1 proved their superiority. Acquisition of North American champion, Peter-Paul Pradeeban was a crucial factor. Torontonians came with the strongest team - Cerna and Wei joined Pradee. On the other side, two best players from Montreal Ling Kun and PL Theirault were on national team training camp in Ottawa preparing for World Junior Championships in Madrid. Ottawa split their games against two Toronto teams and double were crucial in match of second teams from Toronto and Montreal. In that match Toronto 2 avoided the last place.

Comments November 19

Although they won their first match against Montreal 1, Toronto first team has to be fully mobilized if it wants the title. Will Montreal change its team and surprise Pradee, Simon or Jacky?

Ottawa can probably count on one match against Toronto teams which would be likely enough for number 3. Second teams from Montreal and Toronto should fight hard on Sunday to avoid the last position.

Comments after October 12th

Montreal 1 is in the first place, but Toronto 1 has increased its chances tremendously. Playing with Peter-Paul Pradeeban as the best player, this time more confident Simon Wei and very good Jacky Fok, Toronto 1 gave first team from Montreal a lot of homework. The first one is to get its best players together and the second one is to make sure that they don't fail in their games against Simon and Jacky. Not an easy task for a very young team.

Ottawa made its first victory and with Bryant Michaud in team they are more dangerous and more ambitious. In Montreal they will play against teams from Toronto and even Toronto 1 has to take them seriously if they don't want to be surprised.

It looks like the second teams from Toronto and Montreal are giving up the fight for the third position and that their matches in Montreal will be decisive for the No. 4.

Comments after September 28th

Montreal 1 and Toronto 1 have shown their strength. Highly anticipated matches between these two teams on October 26 and November 23 in Montreal will most probably decide the champion. That time and in Toronto on October 12, Toronto 1 will be stronger for Peter-Paul Pradeeban, North American Champion. This time he was busy – representing Canada at World Cup.

Ottawa, Montreal 2 and Toronto 2 will fight for third spot.

How far they will go depends on their and our work, but ICL should be a perfect opportunity for Lolo, Eloise, Marianna, Li Jiawei, Yuri, Yubo... to show their progress.
